I'm not sure what documents you're referring to, but we continue to prioritize the safety and well-being of all of our students. I'm so sorry to hear that these things were said to [REDACTED] last year; this was not shared with any of our school staff last year, or it would have been addressed. If there are unkind comments made this year please encourage [REDACTED] to let her teacher know right away so we can address the comments and reinforce our expectations of respect for all.

In response to your other email today, Mrs. Magana continues in her role of school social worker at All Saints. She works with students when a teacher or parent refers them because their social emotional learning is impacting the learning environment. She will not be seeing [REDACTED] unless a teacher is concerned about [REDACTED] behavior/academics and makes a referral, at which time we would communicate with both of you to determine if school social work is something you both want to move forward with. I believe last year the kids were in outside therapy to process the changes at home, so hopefully that has continued as an additional support for them.

Yes, Tom is part of the school board. Meetings are typically the last Tuesday of the month and are all published on the school calendar available in FACTS Family Portal.
